A project worker will visit you monthly (or more often if you choose) and bring:

- Information about your child's stage of development and what to expect next.
- Ideas to help you help your child to learn develop and prepare for school or nursery.
- Information on local groups and services for families including child-care.
- Simple fun activities for you to share with your child and enjoy together.
- Information about common issues in childhood such as tantrums, sleep, toilet training, weaning and more.
