Please see below a brief overview of each day's activities. More details of all the activities available and the selection process for this are available in the Activities Week brochure.

Monday 11 <sup>th</sup> July: Super-curricular Day	Students will have the opportunity to select two subjects that they would like to participate in for the day. They will participate in workshops in their chosen subjects during the morning, and a second subject during the afternoon. Students will have the opportunity to select these subjects using the <b><u>link posted on the Academy website</u></b> . Alternatively, you can type the link in using the Activities Week brochure or by accessing the link via Google Classroom.
Tuesday 12 <sup>th</sup> , Wednesday 13 <sup>th</sup> and Thursday 14 <sup>th</sup> July – Activity Days	Students will have the opportunity to <b><u>select three activities across these three days (or two activities in two days for Year 10)</u></b> . Please refer to the booklet attached when selecting your chosen activities for the week. Please also note that there will be a cost associated with some activities that must be paid to the Finance Department using <b><u>Parent Pay</u></b> once your child's place has been confirmed for the activity.
Thursday 14 <sup>th</sup> July – Year 10 Deloitte Day	Year 10 students will have the opportunity to participate in a series of workshops led by Deloitte at the Academy. All Year 10 students will be involved in this.
Friday 15 <sup>th</sup> July – Thorpe Park	All Students in Years 7-10 will have the opportunity to attend Thorpe Park on the Friday of Activities Week. The cost associated with this day <b><u>is £25 per student</u></b> and can be paid using <b><u>Parent Pay</u></b> .

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All students will need to make their choices for the week using a **Google Form** that has been posted on the **Academy's website, in their year group's Google Classroom, and has also been included in the Activities Week brochure**. You will need to login to your child's Google Classroom account in order to access the link.

**Students can only submit this Google Form once**, so please choose carefully with your child and regularly refer to the Activities Week brochure provided.
