

Course Entry Requirements - A-Levels

A Level Courses	Course-Specific Entry Requirements
Physics	 If taking combined science – grade 6-6 or above. If taking triple science – grade 6 or above in physics. Grade 6 or above in mathematics GCSE.
Chemistry	 If taking combined science – grade 6-6 or above. If taking triple science – grade 6 or above in chemistry and biology. Grade 6 or above in mathematics GCSE.
Biology	 If taking combined science – grade 6-6 or above. If taking triple science – grade 6 or above in biology and chemistry. Grade 5 or above in mathematics GCSE.
Computer Science	Grade 6 or above in mathematics GCSE.
Mathematics	Grade 7 or above in mathematics GCSE.
English Literature	Grade 6 or above in English literature GCSE.
English Language	Grade 6 or above in English language GCSE.
History	Grade 6 or above in history GCSE or another essay-based GCSE subject.
Geography	Grade 6 or above in geography GCSE or another essay-based GCSE subject.
Philosophy and Ethics	 Grade 6 or above in English language or literature GSCE and/or grade 6 or above in history, geography, RE GCSE or another essay-based GCSE subject.
Politics	 Grade 6 or above in English language or literature GSCE and/or grade 6 or above history, geography or another essay-based GCSE subject.
Economics	Grade 6 or above in English and Mathematics GCSEs.
Business Studies	 Grade 6 or above in Business GCSE, if studied and/or English and Mathematics at grade 6 or above.
Sociology	 Grade 6 or above in English language or literature GSCE and/or grade 6 or above in sociology GCSE or another essay-based GCSE subject.
Psychology	 Grade 6 or above in psychology GCSE or grade 6-6 or above in either combined science or grade 6 or above in biology GCSE. Grade 6 or above in English and mathematics GCSEs.
Spanish	 Grade 6 or above in Spanish GCSE. Will consider home language Spanish speakers without a GCSE In the subject, based on a formal assessment to determine ability to access the course.
French	 Grade 6 or above in French GCSE. Will consider home language French speakers without a GCSE in the subject, based on a formal assessment to determine ability to access the course.
Turkish	 Grade 6 or above in Turkish GCSE. Will consider home language Turkish speakers without a GCSE in the subject, based on a formal assessment to determine ability to access the course.

A Level Courses	Course-Specific Entry Requirements
Media Studies	Grade 6 or above in Media or English language or literature GCSE.
Music	Grade 8 or 9 in music, or the ability to play an instrument to a high level and a separate interview with music department.
Drama	Grade 6 or above in Drama GCSE and/or grade 6 or above in English language or literature GCSE.
Fine Art	Grade 6 in GCSE Art or a Merit or above in Level 2 Art BTEC or grade 6 in a related GCSE subject and submission of portfolio to the Art Department.

BTEC Courses

Level 3 BTEC	Course-Specific Entry Requirements
Health and Social Care BTEC	 Minimum of a grade 5 in English GCSE <u>and</u> mathematics GCSE. L2 Health and Social Care BTEC, if studied, at a merit grade or above.
Business BTEC	 Minimum of a grade 5 in English GCSE <u>and</u> mathematics GCSE. GCSE Business / Economics, if studied, at a minimum of a grade 5. L2 Business BTEC, if studied, at a merit grade or above.
Performing Arts BTEC	 Minimum of a grade 5 in English GCSE <u>and</u> mathematics GCSE. GCSE Drama, if studied, at a minimum of a grade 4.
Sports BTEC	 Minimum of a grade 5 in English GCSE <u>and</u> mathematics GCSE. GCSE PE, if studied, at a minimum of a grade 4. If they have taken L2 Sports BTEC – need to have at least a merit grade.
Applied Art BTEC	 Minimum of a grade 5 in English GCSE <u>and</u> mathematics GCSE. Grade 5 or above in Art or a technology subject. L2 Art BTEC, if studied, at a merit grade or above.

Pathways

	Explanation of Criteria
Academic Pathway	For students predicted at least five grades 9-5 in their GCSEs including English and Maths. Students must also meet the subject specific requirements of their preferred courses.
Mixed Pathway	For students predicted to achieve at least five GCSEs at grade 4 or above, with at least a grade 5 in English <u>and</u> Maths. Students must also meet the subject-specific requirements.
Vocational Pathway	For students predicted to achieve at least five GCSEs at grade 4 or above, with at least a grade 5 in English <u>and</u> Maths. Students must also meet the subject-specific requirements.

If students are predicted to achieve predominantly grades 3 and below (i.e. they are unlikely to meet basic entry criteria for the vocational pathway), we will support them to identify a suitable Level 1 or 2 programme of study at another institution.
